

MEMBER PROFILE - GARY McCARTHY

Nearly 70 years ago, I had my first car which was a 1929 Model A Ford Coupe, that mates and I tinkered about with--- a great learning experience. Then came a 1935 Ford V8 in which we had some great adventures, more muckin' about with cars. On this a friend had painted a white scorpion on the driver's door - my birth sign.





After this time came marriage and responsibilities, and honeymooning to the north in a Jowett Javelin, which I still think was the best riding car I ever had. We had at least 4 A30's, one of which we used to transport cement from J.J. Craig on Kings Wharf to Te Atatu. During the next 45 years a stream of at least 25 cars including Fords, VW's and Toyota Utes. My pride and joy was the VW T L Fastback with a Porsche motor we bought in Western Australia where we had been living and working for about 4 years.





The first-time new car we had, and then towed a home-built camper across the country, from Perth to Sydney. A Triumph Herald to get the chassis on which we built a Kit Kar came next. 1952 MG T F. Another Triumph had us joining the Classic and Sports Car Club in Northland, followed by a Mazda Cabriolet, until in 2022 we bought from Myles Flynn the Triumph we have now. Some restoration, paint job and refit took a little while, but a great deal of pleasure, pride and enjoyment in doing this. We have been on some great trips and outings with the club, and also with the Triumph Club in Auckland where we live. Time and health issues prevent us now being as much involved in the club as we would like but we still enjoy what we do.




